

<b>1000 Lakes Scholarship</b>	This \$3000 recurring scholarship (\$1000 for years 2, 3, and 4) supports the higher education of students in the five Itasca County high schools. Recipients work hard, have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and are pursuing a 4-year college degree. Recipients are selected by the Superintendent or a school committee.
<b>Adam Johnson Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship is for a graduating Hibbing High School senior who will be attending the University of Minnesota Duluth (UMD) and has a GPA of 3.0. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Ardell Simonson Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship is intended for graduating seniors from Grand Rapids, Greenway, Bigfork, or Deer River High Schools who have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and are interested in pursuing a career as an Elementary Educator.
<b>Barbara Swenkofske Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports a graduating GRHS female who plans to attend a 4-Yr College or University or a Community College
<b>Betty Shannon Scholarship (CSS)</b>	This \$2000 recurring scholarship (\$1000 for 2 years) supports a student attending the College of St. Scholastica who is pursuing nursing.
<b>Betty Shannon Scholarship (Minnesota North College - Itasca)</b>	This \$1000 recurring scholarship (\$500 for 2 years) supports a student attending MN North College - Itasca who is pursuing nursing.
<b>Bigfork Lions Scholarship</b>	This \$2000 recurring scholarship (\$1000 for 2 years) is awarded to graduating seniors from the Bigfork High School who demonstrate involvement in the community.
<b>Bill and Ruth Powers Scholarship</b>	This \$1800 scholarship is intended for graduating students from District 318, Grand Rapids and Bigfork, who have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and plan to pursue a major in arts and humanities, architecture and design, music, or education.
<b>Bill Gray - Southwest Elementary Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports students who attended Southwest Elementary School in Grand Rapids MN and are graduating from a Greater Itasca Area school. Not intended for the top students in the class.
<b>Bill Prigge Memorial Economic Scholarship</b>	This \$800 scholarship supports a graduating Greenway High School student with a GPA of 2.5 or higher who plans to study business or economics. Award may be based on need.
<b>Blue Heron Scholarship Fund</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports both traditional and nontraditional students who are graduating or who have graduated from Grand Rapids High School or Bigfork High School who are planning to study environmental science, neurologic healthcare, humanities, STEM: animal science, or veterinary services (doctor or technician).
<b>Bob Frick Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports a graduating Grand Rapids High School senior entering a vocational/technical program (not music or nursing). Priority may be given to a student pursuing graphic arts.

<b>Bob Graf Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports a Greater Itasca County area student(s), both traditional and non-traditional, who is pursuing a technical, trade, or nursing degree and has a GPA of 2.0-3.5. Prior recipients can re-apply.
<b>Bonner Hockey Scholar Award</b>	This \$500 scholarship is awarded to the GRHS graduating senior male and female varsity hockey player (must have played during their senior year) with the highest cumulative GPA on their respective hockey team.
<b>Brad Smith Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$900 scholarship supports a graduating Deer River High School student who demonstrates exceptional commitment to self and community. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Bryan Schlicht Agency, Inc. of American Family Insurance Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports an Itasca County student who is attending a community college or university and majoring in business. This scholarship is available to both traditional and non-traditional students. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Burgess Family Scholarship Fund</b>	This \$2500 recurring scholarship (\$1250 for 2 years) is offered to a student graduating from Deer River High School with a minimum GPA of 2.50, is active in community service and intends to obtain a Bachelor's degree.
<b>Carl &amp; Margaret Mickelson/Kiwanis Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports GRHS Key Club students who demonstrate commitment to community service, have a GPA of 3.0 or above, be a current and active GRHS Key Club member, and may be based on financial need.
<b>Catherine Anderson Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports District 318 (Bigfork and Grand Rapids)graduating females who are interested in pursuing a career in education.
<b>Chad, Holly and Hannah Davis Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship is in memory of Chad, Holly and Hannah Davis and is available to traditional and non-traditional students in District 318 (Bigfork and Grand Rapids) and Greenway. IEP preferred, but not required. Student pursuing nursing or trades preferred. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Coach Ted Brill Hockey Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship is offered to a GRHS male varsity hockey player who demonstrates leadership.
<b>Coach Tom Drazenovich Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship is offered to a GRHS male varsity football player who demonstrates leadership.
<b>Community Foundation General Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship is intended for a Greater Itasca Area student who has a solid academic record and is pursuing further education.
<b>Corey Bakken Speech and Debate Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports graduating seniors from District 318, Bigfork and Grand Rapids High Schools who have actively participated in speech and debate. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Dan Retka Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports GRHS graduating seniors with a GPA of 3.0 or higher who plan to study engineering, construction management or environmental science. Past recipients may re-apply.

<b>Dede Emerson Scholarship Fund</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports graduating GRHS seniors who have 3.0 GPA or higher and are enrolled in a 2-year or 4-year college and who plan to pursue a degree in international business, veterinarian work, music, or humanities.
<b>Dr. and Mrs. Robert Kelly Scholarship</b>	This \$2500 scholarship is intended for an individual who has earned at least a high school diploma and due to life or career circumstances, has experienced an "interruption" in their career path. The ideal candidate is someone who has decided to pursue a career track in the healthcare field. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Dr. Jules &amp; Ilo Meyer Medical Scholarship</b>	This \$5000 scholarship supports traditional and nontraditional students entering medical school, dental school, veterinarian school or a registered nursing program.
<b>Eagle Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports traditional or nontraditional students in the Greater Itasca Area who plan to attend a Christian-centered college, university, Bible college, or seminary. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Ed &amp; Eleanore Gregerson Scholarship</b>	This \$10,000 recurring scholarship (\$2500 for four years) supports GRHS graduating seniors who are active members of the Zion Lutheran Church of Grand Rapids and who plan on pursuing a 4-year degree
<b>Edgar R and Bess R Mullins Award</b>	This \$1500 scholarship is awarded to one female and one male graduating senior from Greenway High School who demonstrates athletic involvement, leadership, and commitment to GHS and their community.
<b>Erling &amp; Fran Willadson Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports graduating GRHS seniors who are pursuing a vocational or technical school program. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Essentia Health - Future in Healthcare Scholarship</b>	This \$5,000 scholarship supports a Greater Itasca Area student, both traditional and nontraditional, who is pursuing a major in healthcare that includes dental and mental health services and maintains a GPA of 3.25 or higher. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Forrest Willey Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports GRHS and Northern Lights Community School graduating seniors who have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
<b>Foster Hope Scholarship Fund</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports traditional and nontraditional students in the Greater Itasca Area who are currently in the foster care system, have previously been in the foster care system, or who have been adopted through the foster care system and who are pursuing further education and have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Frances Bartos King - James E King Scholarship</b>	This \$2000 scholarship supports female Greater Itasca Area graduating high seniors who are pursuing further education. May be based on financial need. Past recipients may re-apply
<b>Freestone Community Club Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports graduating seniors from GRHS who live in the Arbo, Bass Lake, Deer Lake or Wabana Townships.
<b>Gary Ehalt "His Love For Animals" Veterinary Scholarship</b>	This \$750 scholarship supports Greater Itasca Area students, both traditional and non-traditional, interested in becoming a veterinarian. Past recipients may re-apply.

<b>G.J. Holt Family Scholarship</b>	This \$6000 recurring scholarship (\$1500 for 4 yrs) supports Bigfork High School graduating seniors who are pursuing further education. It is renewable up to three additional years based on student progress and performance in their schooling.	
<b>Grand Itasca Clinic &amp; Hospital Volunteer Services Scholarship</b>	This \$3000 scholarship supports Greater Itasca Area students who have at least two years of postsecondary education and are pursuing a career in healthcare. Past recipients may re-apply.	
<b>Grand Itasca Foundation Scholarship</b>	This scholarship is for students pursuing a career in the field of health care. A personal interview is required for this scholarship.	
<b>Grand Rapids AAUW Anniversary Scholarship</b>	The Grand Rapids Branch of AAUW provides a \$1500 scholarship each year for a woman who has completed a minimum of an associate degree or equivalent, who is 25 years or older, and working toward a certification program, a bachelor's degree, or a master's degree. In 2006, the Grand Rapids AAUW Branch, to commemorate their 60th anniversary, began a drive to provide the Anniversary Scholarship. Past recipients may re-apply.	
<b>Grand Rapids/Greenway Swim Association Scholarship</b>	This \$750 scholarship supports two graduating seniors from GRHS or GHS pursuing further education who participated in at least 3 years of competitive swimming, preferably at the varsity level, who have a GPA of 2.5 or higher, and who demonstrate team leadership, good sportsmanship, promote team spirit, unselfishness and have a willingness to help others.	
<b>Greater Itasca STEM Scholarship</b>	This \$2000 scholarship supports Greater Itasca Area students, both traditional and nontraditional, who are pursuing further education in the fields of science, technology, engineering or math (STEM), but not going into a healthcare-related field. Past recipients may re-apply.	
<b>Greater Itasca VoTech/Community College Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports Greater Itasca Area students, traditional or nontraditional, who intend to pursue education at a community college, vocational, or technical institution. Past recipients may re-apply.	
<b>Greenway Spanish Scholarship</b>	This \$750 scholarship supports graduating seniors from Greenway High School who successfully pass the Spanish III course, display a love for the language, show effort in class and utilize Spanish in and out of the classroom.	
<b>GRHS Class of '85 Legacy Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports GRHS students, both traditional and nontraditional, who are pursuing further education. Preference may be given to students based on financial need.	
<b>GRSB Financial Focus Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship is awarded to graduating seniors from the Greater Itasca Area. The student receiving the scholarship must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and be enrolled in a Community, Technical, College or University. This scholarship is given to students going into a financial focused related field.	
<b>Foster Hope Scholarship Fund</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports traditional and nontraditional students in the Greater Itasca Area who are currently in the foster care system, have previously been in the foster care system, or who have been adopted through the foster care system and who are pursuing further education and have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. Students can re-apply.	

<b>Hazel Brink Music Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports Greater Itasca Area students, traditional and nontraditional, who are pursuing the study of music. Preference may be given to a GRHS graduate. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Hill City Area Community Scholarship</b>	This \$1500 scholarship supports graduating seniors from Hill City High School.
<b>Hill City Classmates Memorial Scholarship Fund</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports students from Hill City High School, both traditional and nontraditional, who are pursuing further education.
<b>Itasca Vintage Car Club Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports a Greater Itasca Area student who is attending a two- or four-year school who plans to pursue a degree/certification in an automotive-related field. Includes diesel mechanic, auto body, machine tool, or engineering. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Jack Gunderson Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports DRHS graduating seniors who have a GPA of 3.0 or higher, demonstrate commitment to school and community, and who are pursuing a career in education
<b>Jennifer Koprowski Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports a GRHS female swimmer who has shown dedication to the sport and leadership ability.
<b>Jim Gibeau Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship is in honor of Jim Gibeau and supports a Greater Itasca Area graduating senior who is a relative of an active or retired Itasca County firefighter.
<b>John and Carol Setterberg Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports DRHS graduating seniors with a GPA of 3.5 or higher and who have a record of participation in sports.
<b>John and Frances Furlong Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports GRHS graduating seniors who pursue a degree or certification from a vocational or technical training program. The scholarship will be awarded to the student with the highest GPA.
<b>Judy Peura Hultquist Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports graduating seniors from Hill City High School with a GPA of 2.0 or higher who are pursuing further education. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>J.W. Kumpula Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports a Nashwauk Keewatin High School graduating senior who plans to pursue a technical career.
<b>Karen Lonson AAUW-GRGM Memorial Scholarship</b>	The Grand Rapids Branch of AAUW provides a \$4000 scholarship each year for a woman who has completed a minimum of an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or the equivalent of two years of college, who is 25 years or older, and working toward a certification program, a bachelor's degree, or an advanced degree majoring in a business-related field. In 2006, the Grand Rapids AAUW Branch, to commemorate their 60th anniversary, began a drive to provide the Anniversary Scholarship.
<b>K. Roger Betz Vocational School Scholarship</b>	This \$1500 recurring scholarship (\$750 in year 1 and year 2) supports students, both traditional and nontraditional, from Greenway High School who are pursuing a vocational or technical degree or certification.

<b>Kurt L. (Buzz) &amp; Jean A. Samuelson Scholarship</b>	This \$2000 scholarship supports Greenway High School graduates, traditional or nontraditional, who plan to obtain a trade/technical degree. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Latterell Family Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports a Bigfork High School graduating senior who plans to attend a four-year college or university. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Lavona M. Jasper Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports Greenway High School graduating seniors with a minimum GPA of 3.0 who are pursuing further education.
<b>Lilah Maddy Brandon Scholarship</b>	This \$4000 recurring scholarship (\$1000/year for four years) supports a Grand Rapids High School graduating senior. Based on need. This scholarship is only given out every four years. 2023, 2027, 2031
<b>Lou and Mary Alice Barle Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports a graduating senior from Greenway High School who is involved in sports.
<b>Max Fulton Forestry Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports Greater Itasca Area students, both traditional and nontraditional, who are pursuing a forestry or forestry-related degree. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>MDI Success at Work Scholarship</b>	This \$2000 scholarship supports students attending schools in the MDI (MN Diversified Industries) areas who are majoring in special education, American Sign Language, human services: (counseling, mental health, psychology, social services, social work), healthcare: (audiology, neurology, occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech pathology). Also eligible are those with an IEP or 504 plan. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Mel and Lucille Beier Family Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports Greater Itasca Area students, both traditional and nontraditional, who are majoring in business. May be based on financial need. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Mel and Nancy Kooda Memorial Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports graduating seniors from McGregor High School who are pursuing a degree in the trades, teaching/education, nursing or medical. Preference may be given to students with fewer scholarship opportunities. Past recipients may re-apply.
<b>Mike Washburn Memorial Scholarship Fund</b>	This \$500 scholarship supports Hill City High School students, both traditional and nontraditional, who are pursuing a degree or certification in heavy equipment operation. Past recipients may re-apply.

Past recipients may re-apply.	
<b>Truman and Borghild "Bud" Shoaff Family Memorial Scholarship</b>	The \$1000 scholarship supports Greater Itasca Area students, both traditional and nontraditional, who are pursuing further education in the STEM (Science Technology, Engineering and Math) fields or in a music field. Past recipients may re-apply.	
<b>Turna E. Fletcher Scholarship</b>	This \$1000 scholarship supports graduating seniors from Deer River High School who are pursuing a degree in the education or environmental fields.
